Westminster Shorter Catechism

Q/A. 45 – *Which is the first commandment?* The first commandment is, You shall have no other gods before me.

Q/A. 46 – *What is required in the first commandment?* The first commandment requires us to know and acknowledge God to be the only true God, and our God; and to worship and glorify him accordingly.

Q/A. 47 – *What is forbidden in the first commandment?* The first commandment forbids the denying, or not worshipping and glorifying the true God as God, and our God; and the giving of that worship and glory to any other, which is due to him alone.

Q/A. 48 – *What are we specially taught by these words [before me] in the first commandment?* These words [before me] in the first commandment teach us, That God, who seeth all things, taketh notice of, and is much displeased with, the sin of having any other God.
